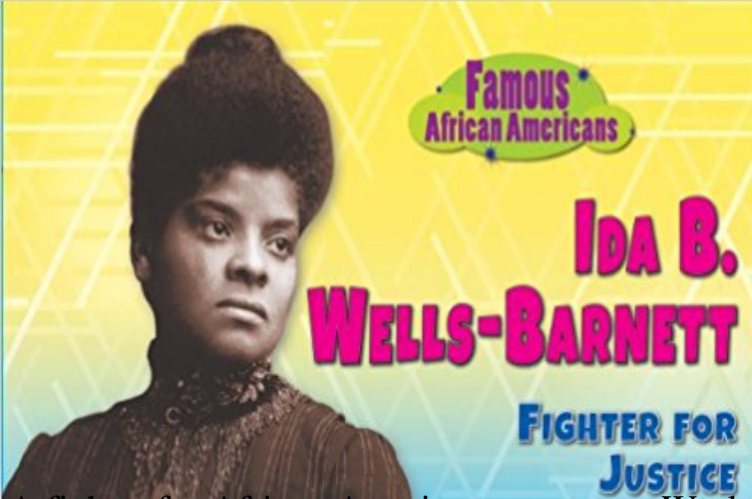


Ida B. Wells Barnett: Fighter for Justice (Famous African Americans)
