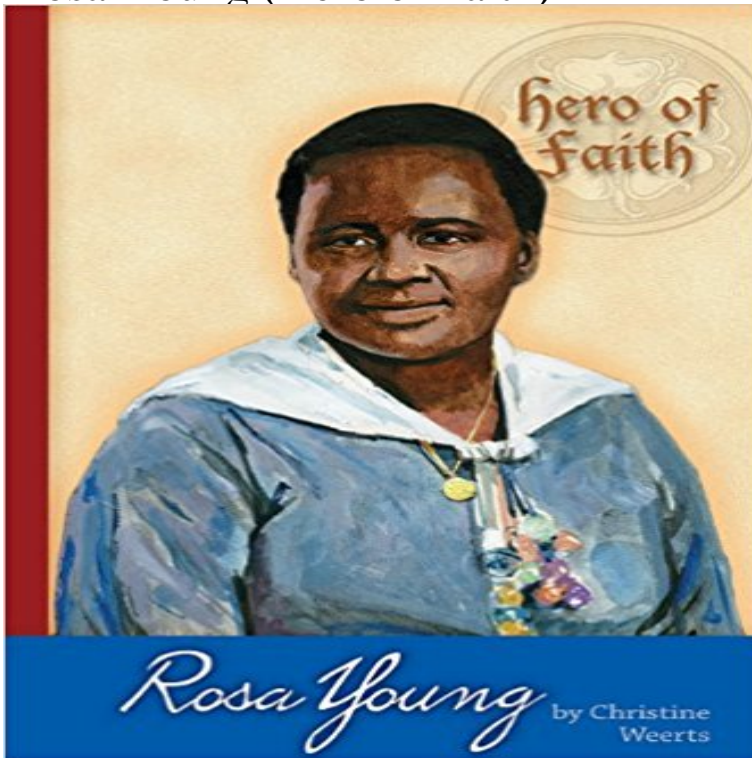


Rosa Young (Hero of Faith)

Young readers will enjoy learning more about Rosa's life, her work, and her passion for education. She truly was a pioneer missionary who initiated Lutheran Christian Education in Alabama.
