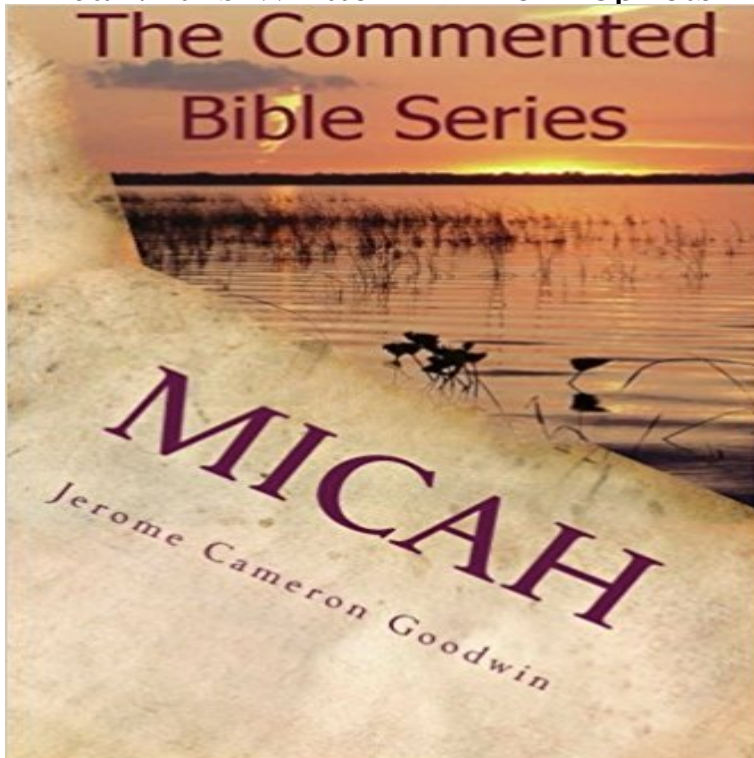


Micah: It Is Written In The Prophets
