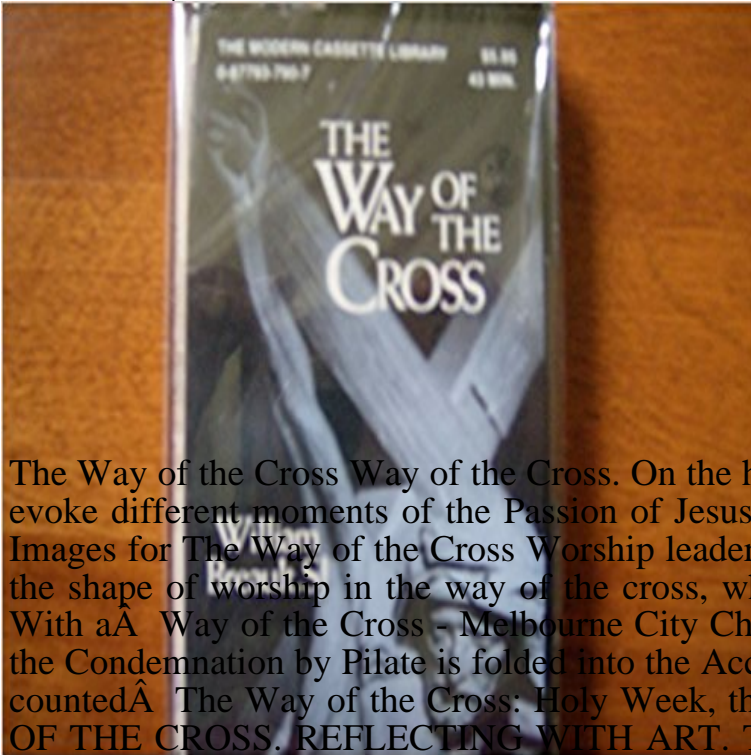


# The Way of the Cross
