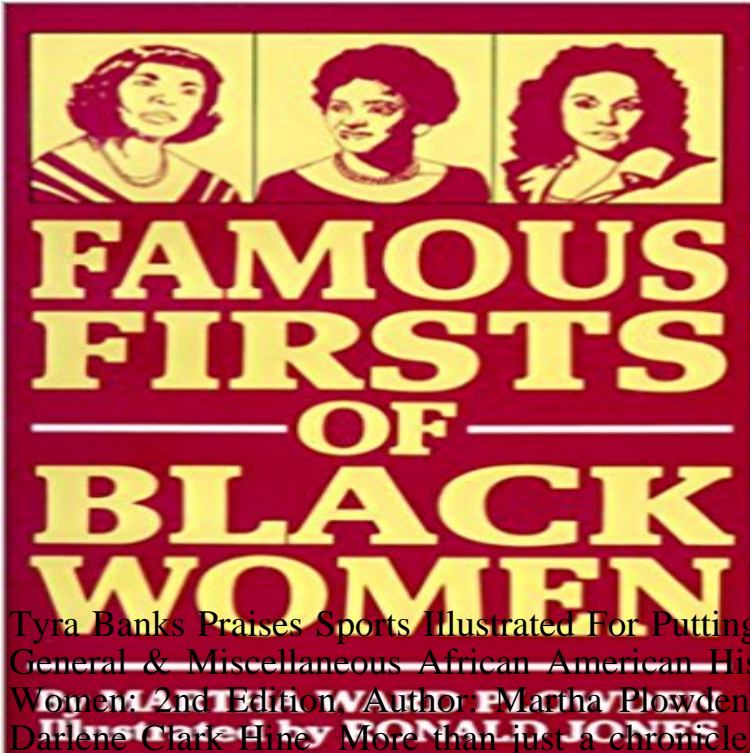


Famous Firsts of Black Women: 2nd Edition
