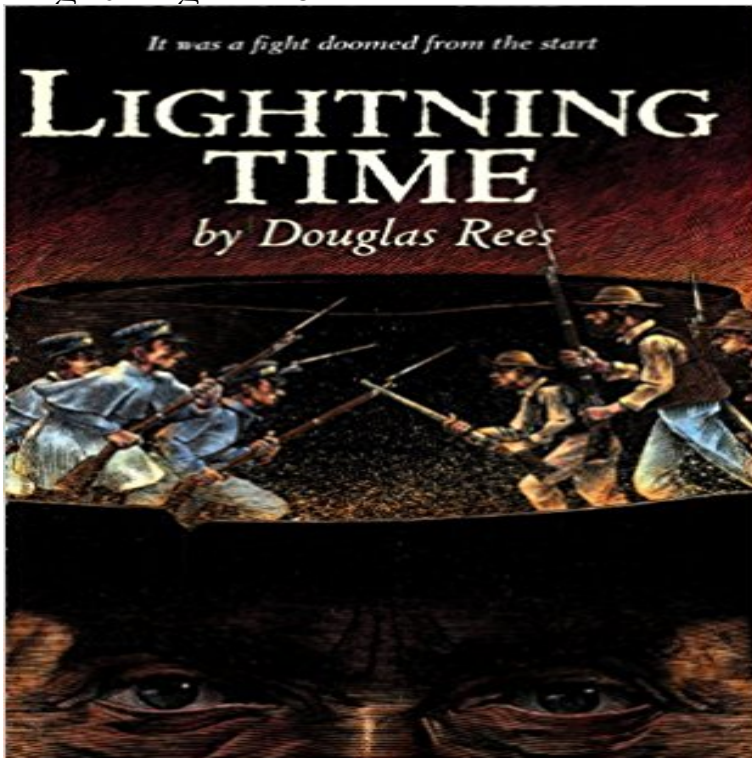


Lightning Time
