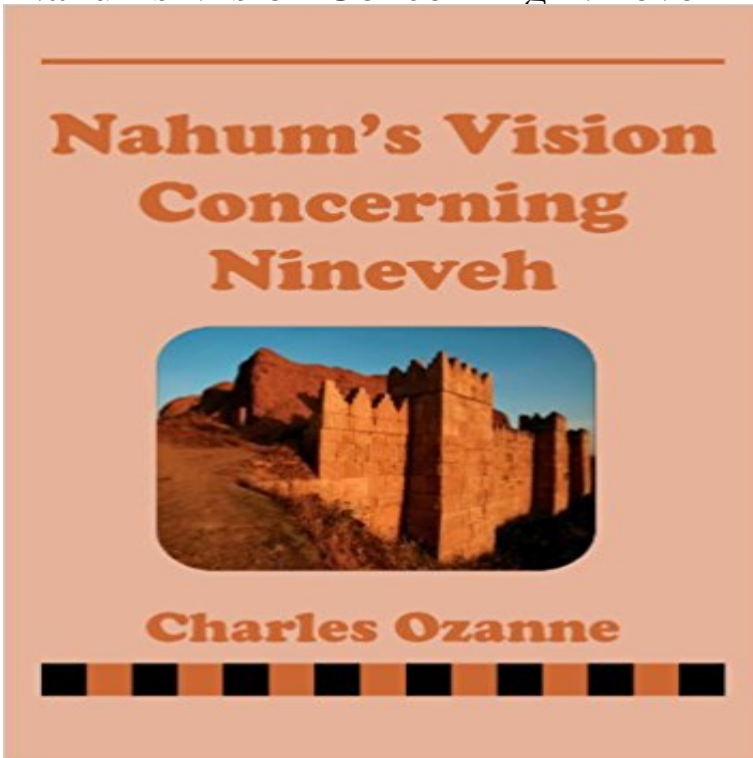


Nahums Vision Concerning Nineveh
