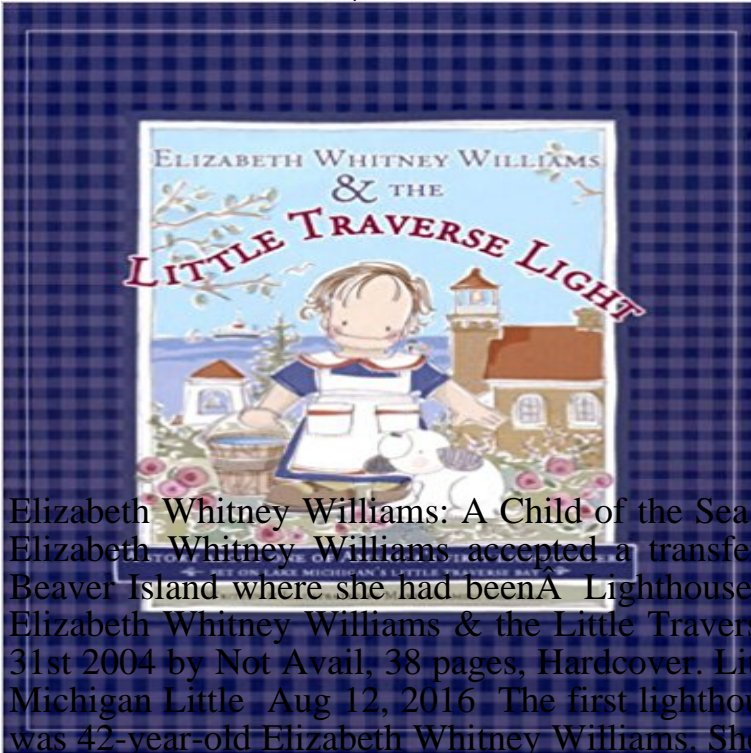


Elizabeth Whitney Williams and the Little Traverse Light
