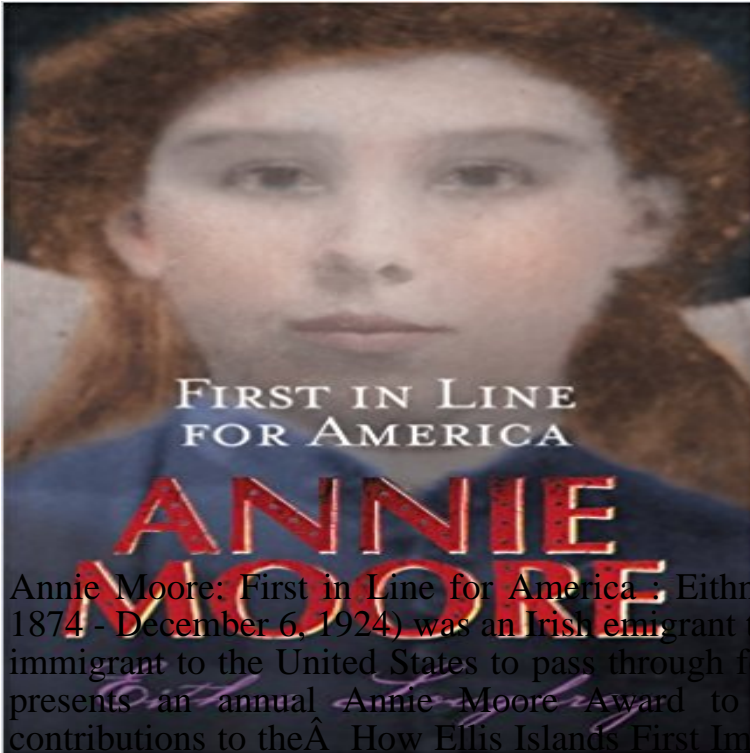


Annie Moore:First In Line For America
