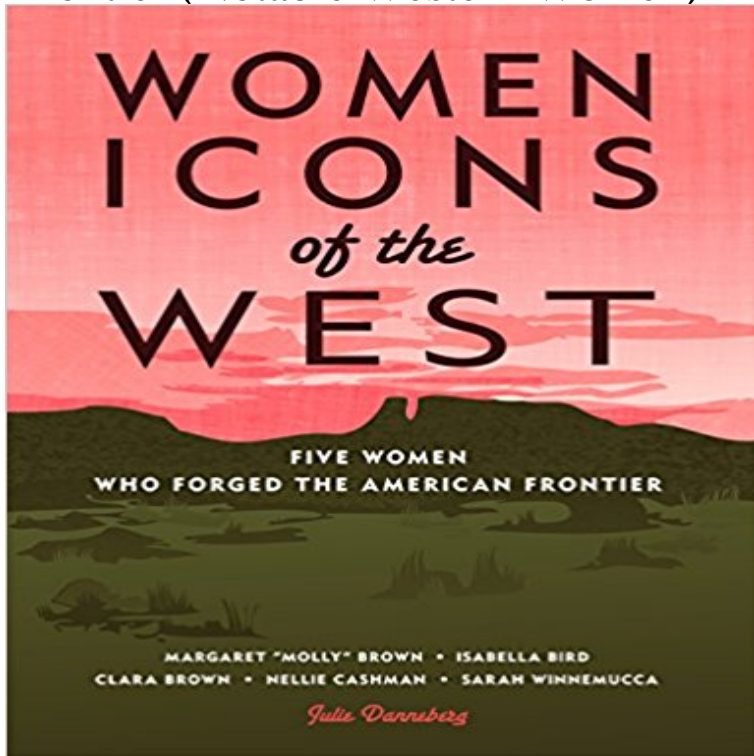


Women Icons of the West: Five Women Who Forged the American Frontier (Notable Western Women)
