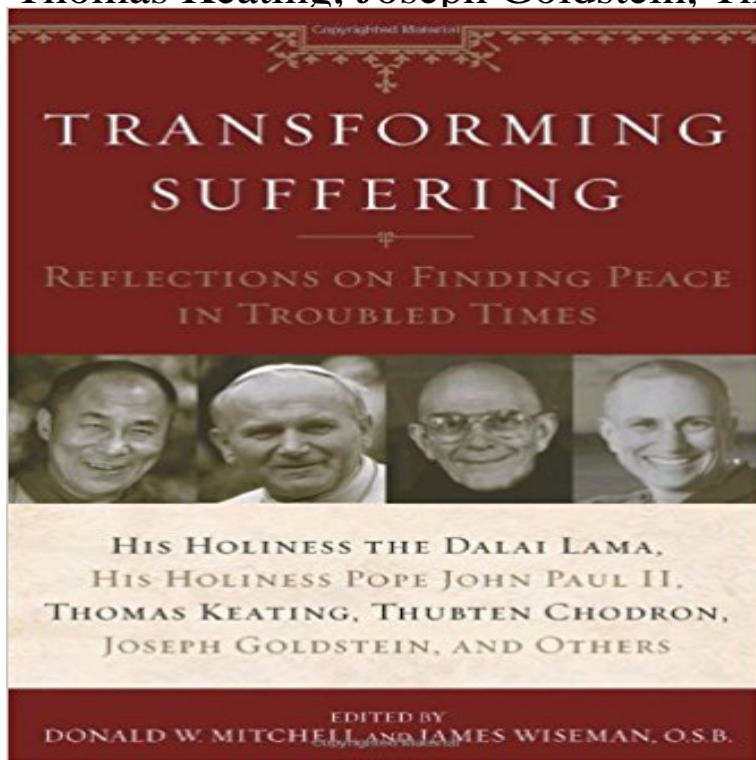


Transforming Suffering: Reflections on Finding Peace in Troubled Times
