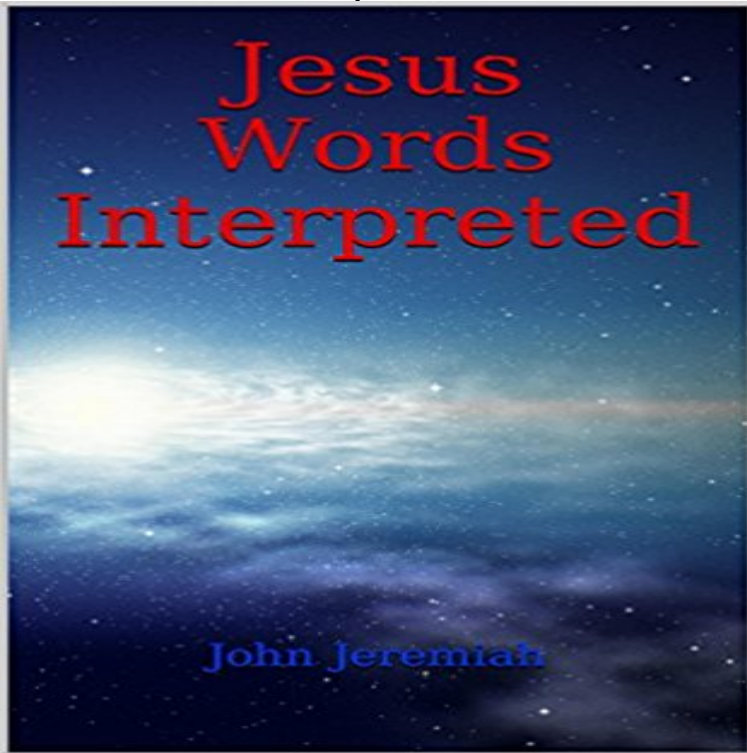


Jesus Words Interpreted
