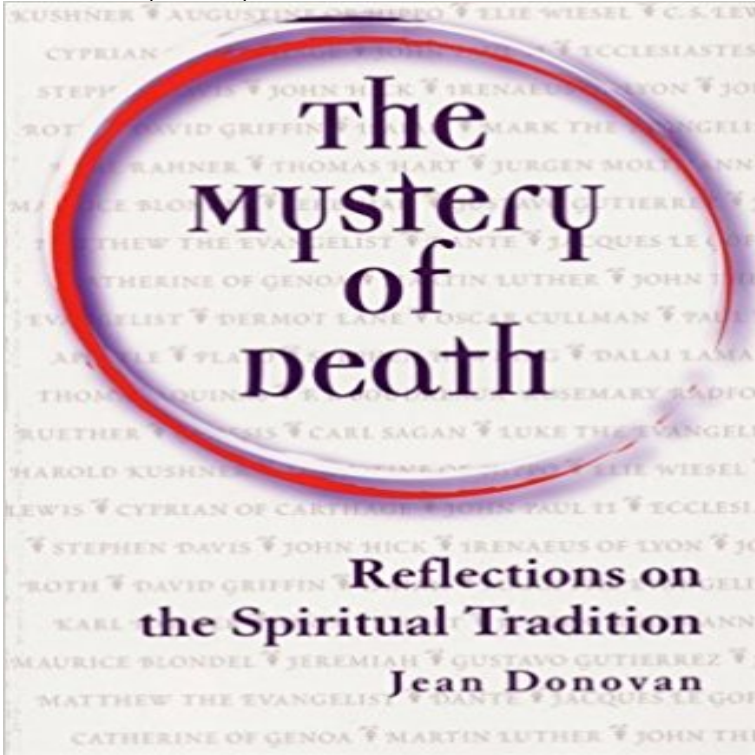


The Mystery of Death: Reflections on the Spiritual Tradition
